Working on clean energy production solutions for agricultural products transformation, we would like to congratulate the developers for this meaningful methodology.

However, we would like to mention that the interdiction of its applicability to a Programme of Activities can strongly decrease its potential of use, even more if we consider small scale agriculture. Project developers might use plantations applicability conditions and wider leakage accounting rules for biomass like the ones proposed in the approved CDM AMS-I.B in order to allow programmatic projects.
