The TGC is an independent and external body of experts and shall be the main responsible decision-making body for all technical matters within the Gold Standard Foundation. The TGC shall comprise of 10-12 members representing the different Gold Standard Foundation's key stakeholder groups. Gold Standard seeks to ensure gender balance and geographical diversity, therefore Women candidates and candidates from Least Developed and Developing Countries are encouraged to apply.
